

Padre's Point of View . . .

Just recently I have had to make a very difficult decision. I am canceling this year's Corpus Christi procession from St. Anthony to Sacred Heart. The reasons are many; a few are listed below. I have consulted with various staff members and it seems best to cancel.

The City of Effingham will not permit us to walk on the street as in a parade; we would have to parade on the sidewalk. This will inhibit a proper procession. It would be difficult to cover the Blessed Sacrament along the route on a sidewalk. Sound and transportation will be difficult to manage from a sidewalk.

Corpus Christi falls on Father's Day and many families have other activities planned.

Please take time to pray with the Blessed Sacrament to honor Jesus in another way.
