I am happy to call you ~ my parishioners. Every week, I will celebrate a Mass for our parishioners and ask for your prayers for me as we begin this journey together. I officially became the pastor on Saturday, July 1; however, there will be a special celebration on Monday, July 10, at 6:00pm, at Sacred Heart Church.

***For a little history on the Installation of a pastor . . .***

When a new pastor is appointed to a parish, it is appropriate that he be publicly installed by a liturgical rite. Bishop Thomas John Paprocki, joined by diocesan and visiting clergy, will officiate at the Mass during which the Installation will take place. All parishioners, guests, and friends are invited and encouraged to attend.

The Installation ceremony begins with the Bishop asking the congregation to express approval and support of their new pastor. As it continues, the new pastor is charged with his duties “as pastor and teacher” and welcomed into the parish family. The parish staff and the parish council who will assist the new pastor with the pastoral care of the people of the parish, are formally presented to him.

To become pastor, for the first time, is a significant and memorable experience for a priest. And, we are marking this Installation of Fr. Michal Rosa with an evening of fellowship. The Knights of Columbus, as well as members of the FACE orchestra, will be joining us. Following Mass, everyone is invited to the Sacred Heart Parish Center for Polish hors d’oeuvres and desserts, catered from Chicago by the famous Mantrose Deli.

*Let us begin this new chapter in the history of Sacred Heart Parish by coming together to give Fr. Michal a warm Sacred Heart welcome.*

Proclaiming the joy of the Gospel is the mission entrusted by the Lord to His Church. In keeping with this mission, Pope Francis is introducing a new approach through a 2018 Bishops' Synod with the topic, "Young People, the Faith and Vocational Discernment." The Church has decided to examine herself on how she can lead young people to recognize and accept the call to the fullness of life and love, and to ask young people to help her in identifying the most effective ways to announce the Good News today.
