### **Attention Sacred Heart School families:**

*We are excited to begin our 125<sup>th</sup> year at Sacred Heart School, and we will welcome you all back to school on Thursday, August 18! Thank you for choosing SHS, and partnering with us to educate your child(ren) and foster his/her faith formation.*

*Here are a few reminders and dates to mark on your calendars:*

**Our Registration/Payment Day will be held Thursday, August 4, from 11:00am until 6:00pm, in the school lobby.** All registration forms not completed online must be completed and returned this day; all school fees as well as a minimum of two weeks of lunch for your student(s) must be paid on this day. Please note these health requirements for the 2016/2017 school year: Incoming kindergarten students need to obtain a complete physical from a doctor's office, a vision exam, and a dental exam. Incoming second grade students need a dental exam. And, incoming sixth grade students need to have a physical from a doctor's office, as well as a dental exam. Incoming preschool students need to have a physical, diabetes screening, and a lead screening.
